The international contest has become the largest children's literary contest in Russia: more than 2 million children attended it from 84 countries, including Argentina, Mexico, Great Britain, Finland, France, Slovenia, Turkey, Canada, Estonia, Bulgaria, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Spain, Belarus, Armenia and others, and 85 regions of the Russian Federation.

Since it still be the school year in Russia as well, children will be enrolled in a Russian school in the camp where the contest will be held, and the children will have daily classes in math, social studies, history, English and Russian language and literature classes.

The Contest is held under the patronage of the Russian Ministry of Education and Science and the Russian Ministry of Culture. One of the many goals of the competition is bringing the school-age children closer to timeless classics.
